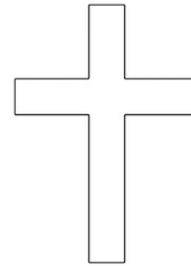




# CHRISTIAN SYMBOLS

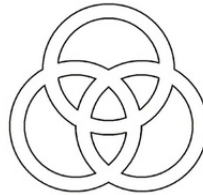


The "Chi-Rho" represents the first two letters of the Greek word for Christ

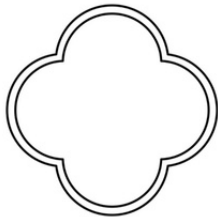


The cross is a symbol for Christ and Christianity

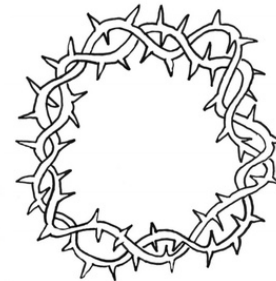
The "trefoil" represents the Trinity



The three nails represents the crucifixion of Jesus, also known as the passion of the Christ



The "quatrefoil" represents the four evangelists and Gospels: Matthew, Mark, Luke and John

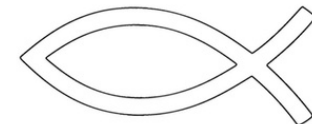


The crown of thorns was placed on Jesus' head during his crucifixion, and also represents the passion of the Christ

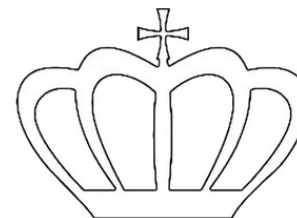
The "triquetra" or "Trinity Knot" represents the Holy Trinity. The circle represents the unity of the three



The "ichthys" represents the letters for the word fish in Greek whose letters mean Christ



The "Alpha and Omega" represent the first and last letters of the Greek alphabet and means Jesus—the beginning and the end



The crown, or "diadem", represents Jesus—the king of kings

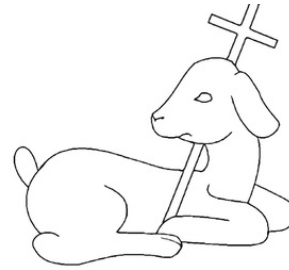
"IHS" represents The first three letters in Greek for Jesus

Wheat is a symbol of God's bounty

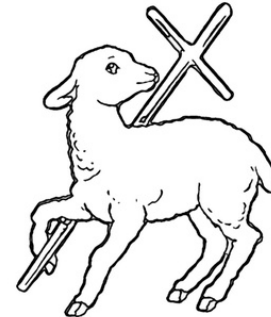


The lamb or "Agnus Dei" represents Jesus Christ

The bread and chalice represents the Eucharist, or Holy Communion—the body and blood of Jesus



A standing lamb with a cross represents Christ's victory over death



The shepherd's staff represents God's guidance over us



The dove represents peace and the Holy Spirit

The fleur-de-lis is a French symbol made up of three parts, representing the Holy Trinity



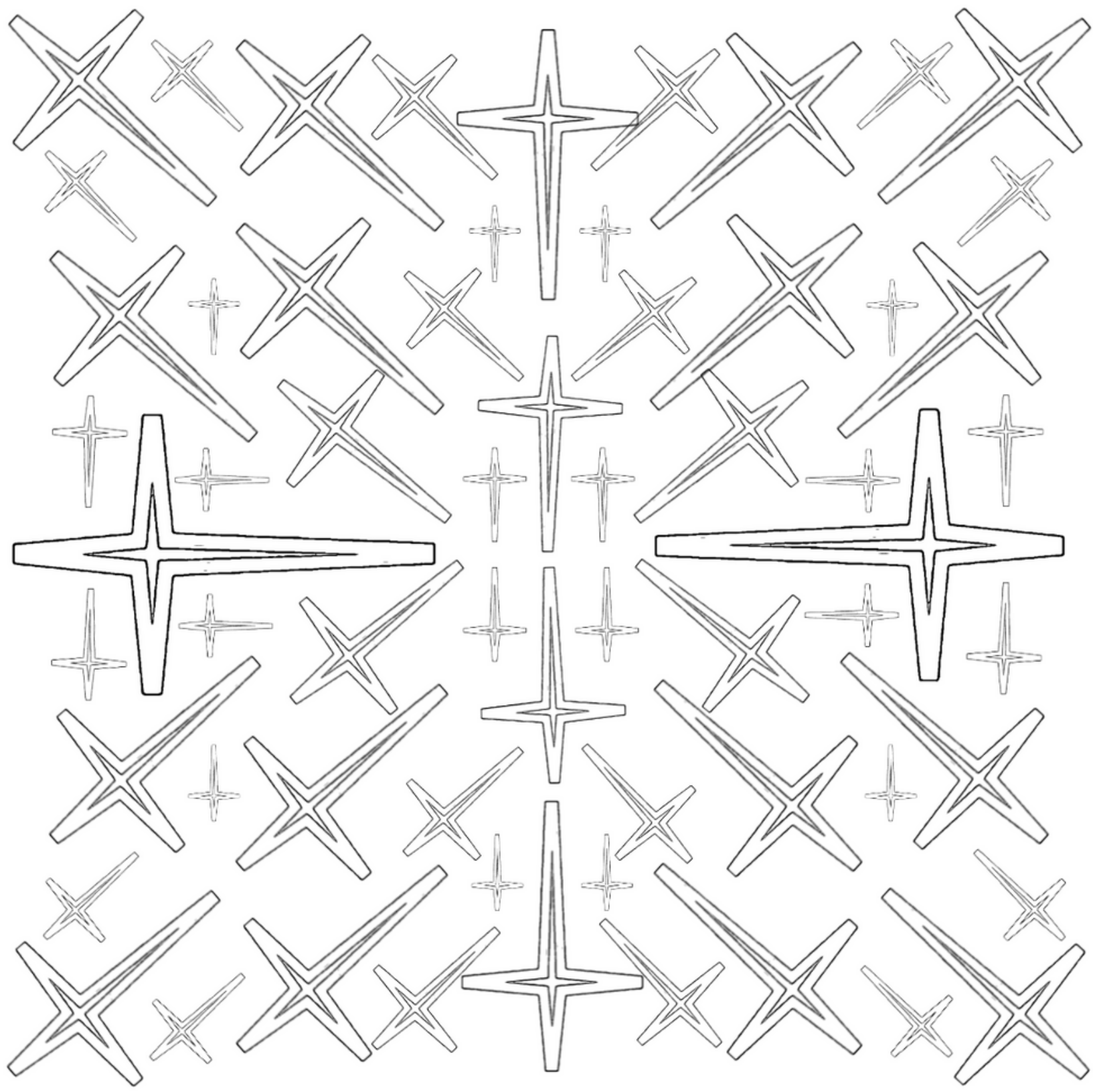
The anchor represents hope and Christ

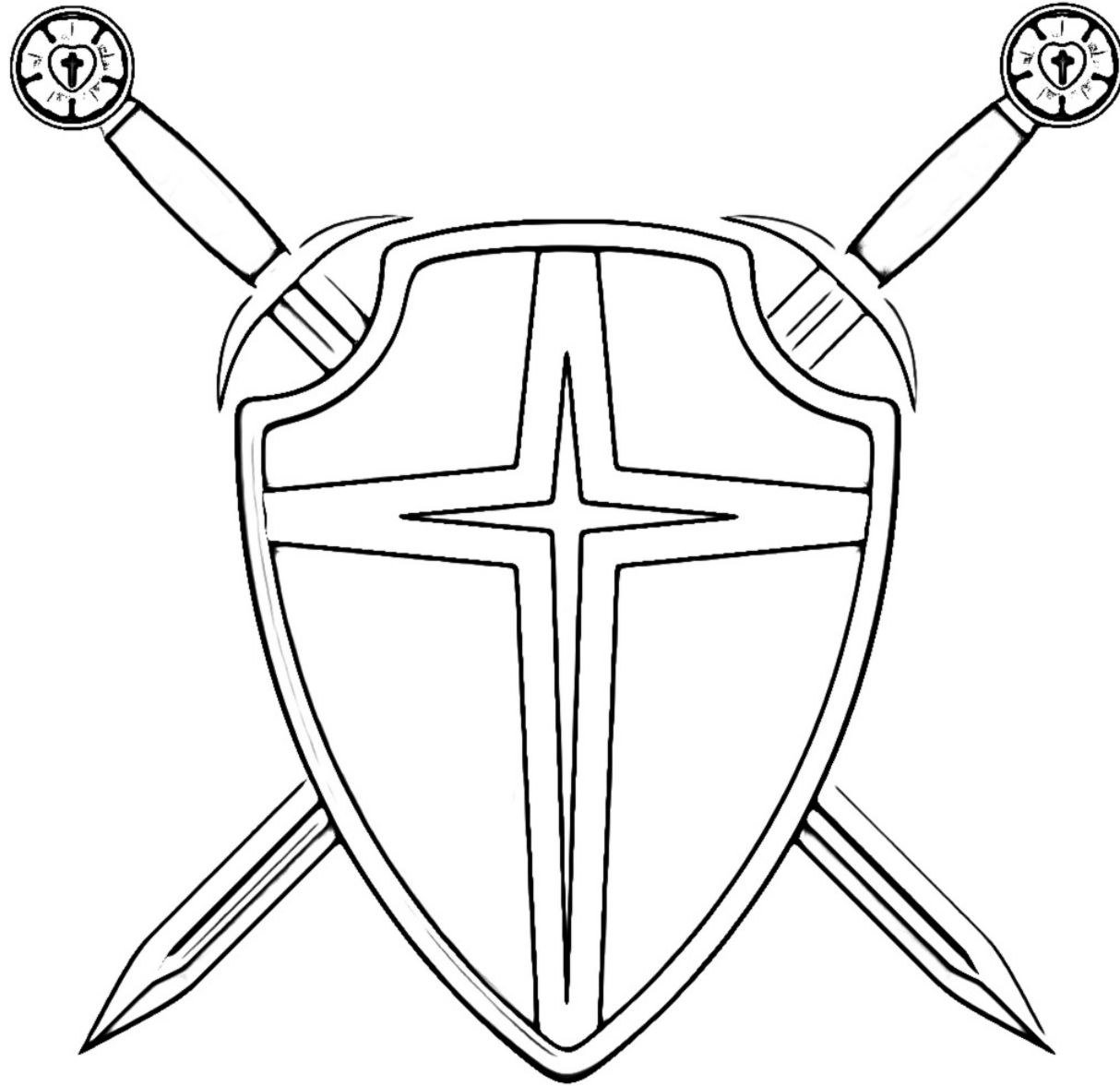
The butterfly is a symbol of the resurrection



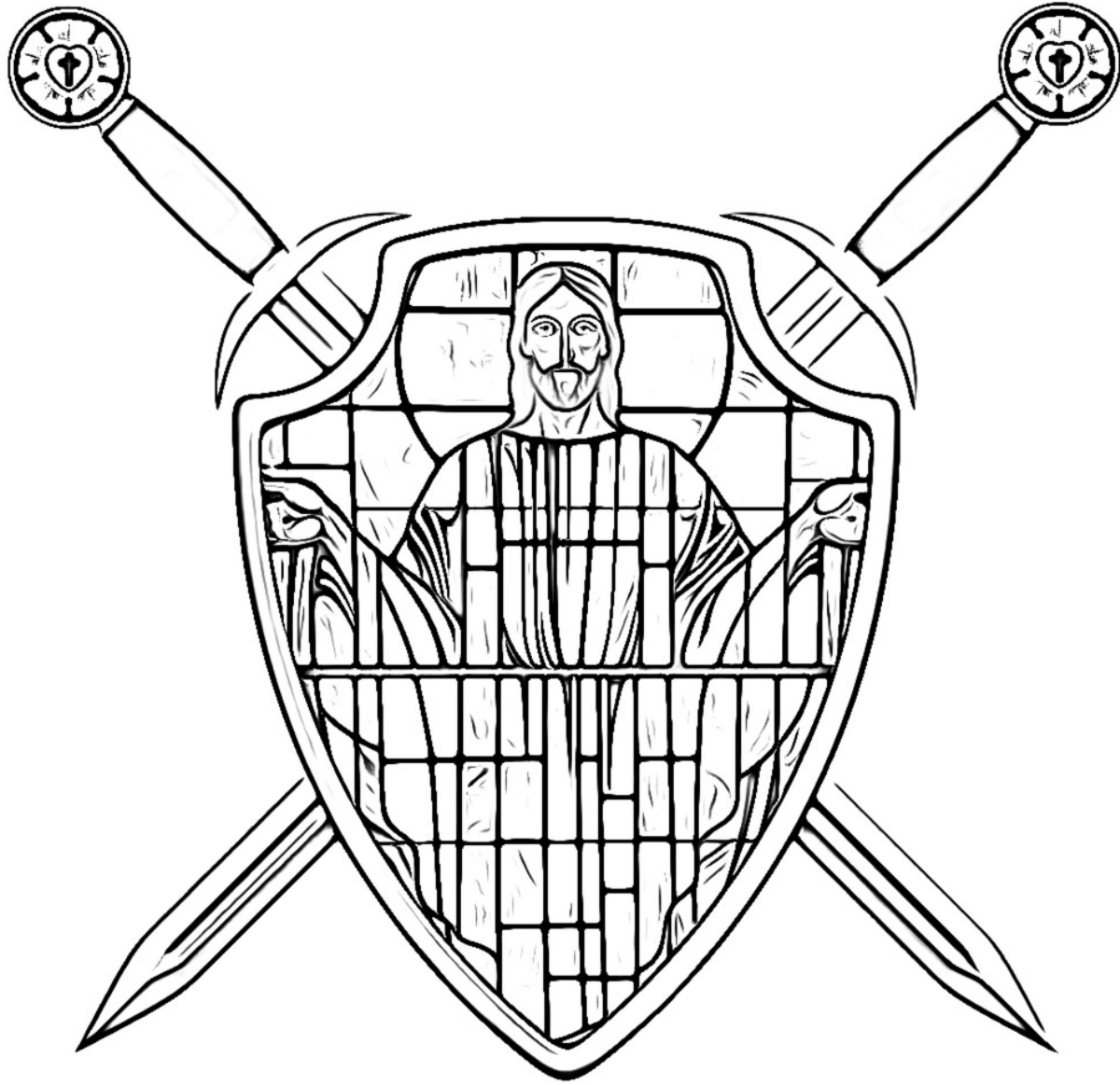
The lighthouse represents Jesus—the light of the world





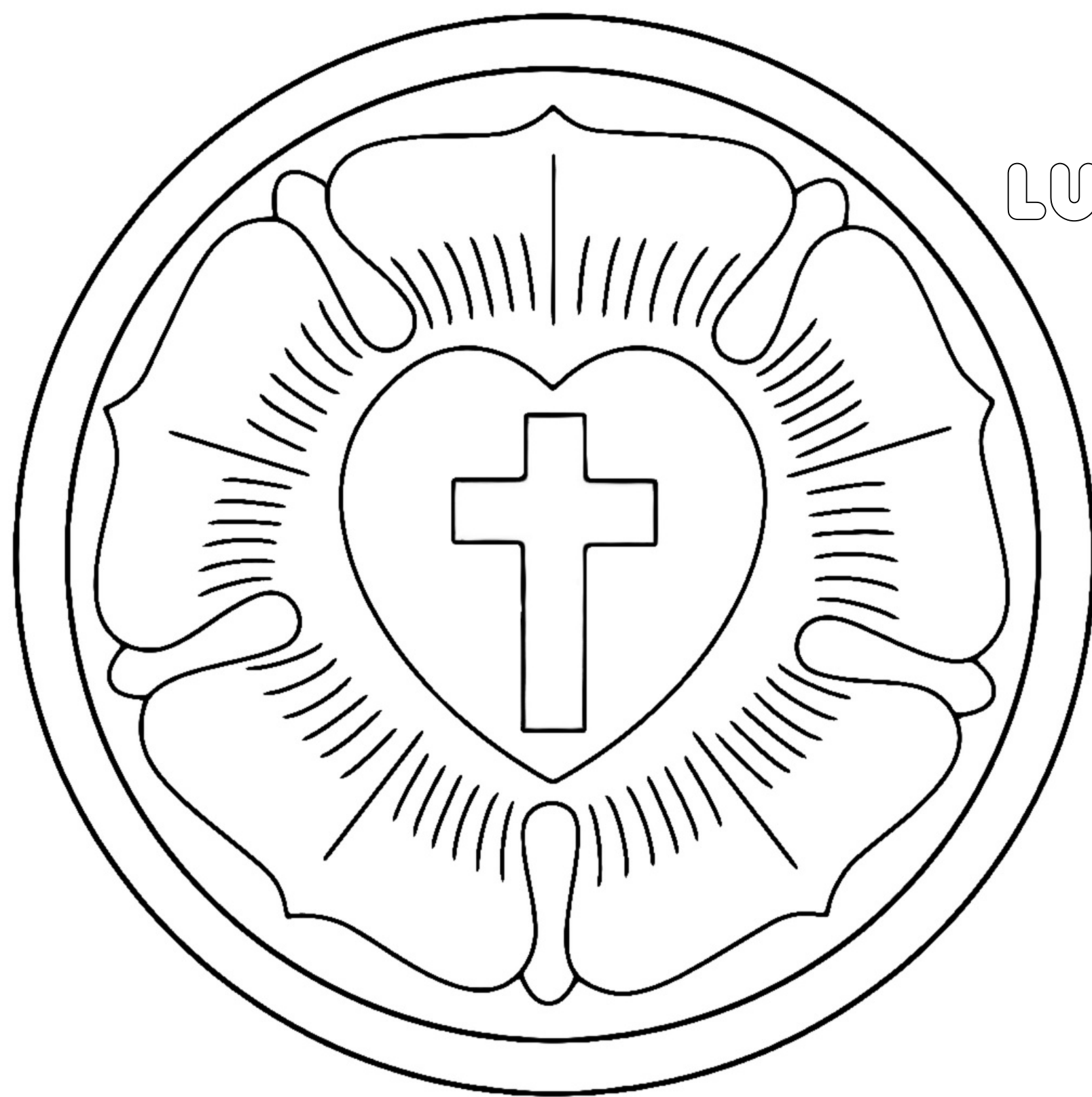

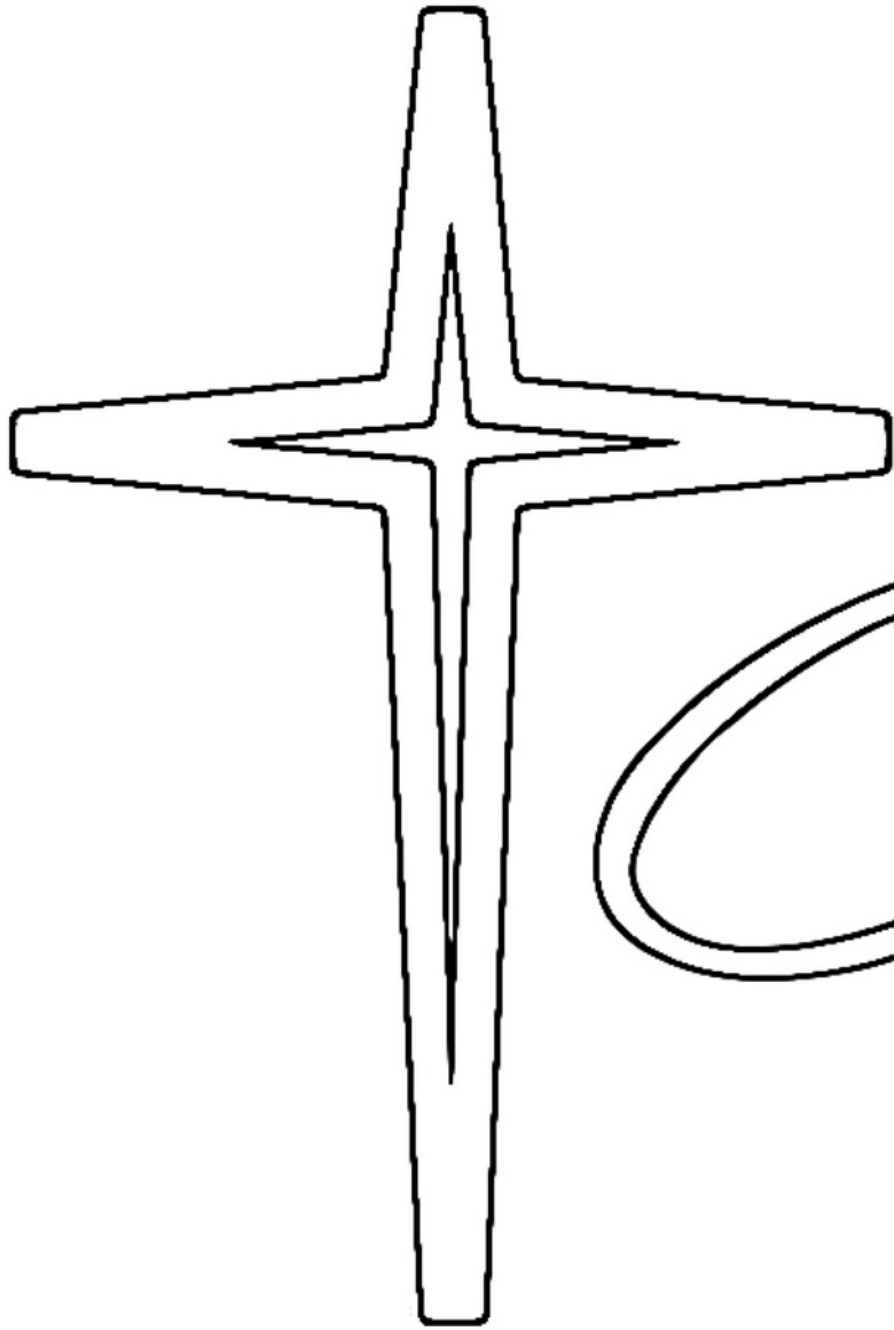

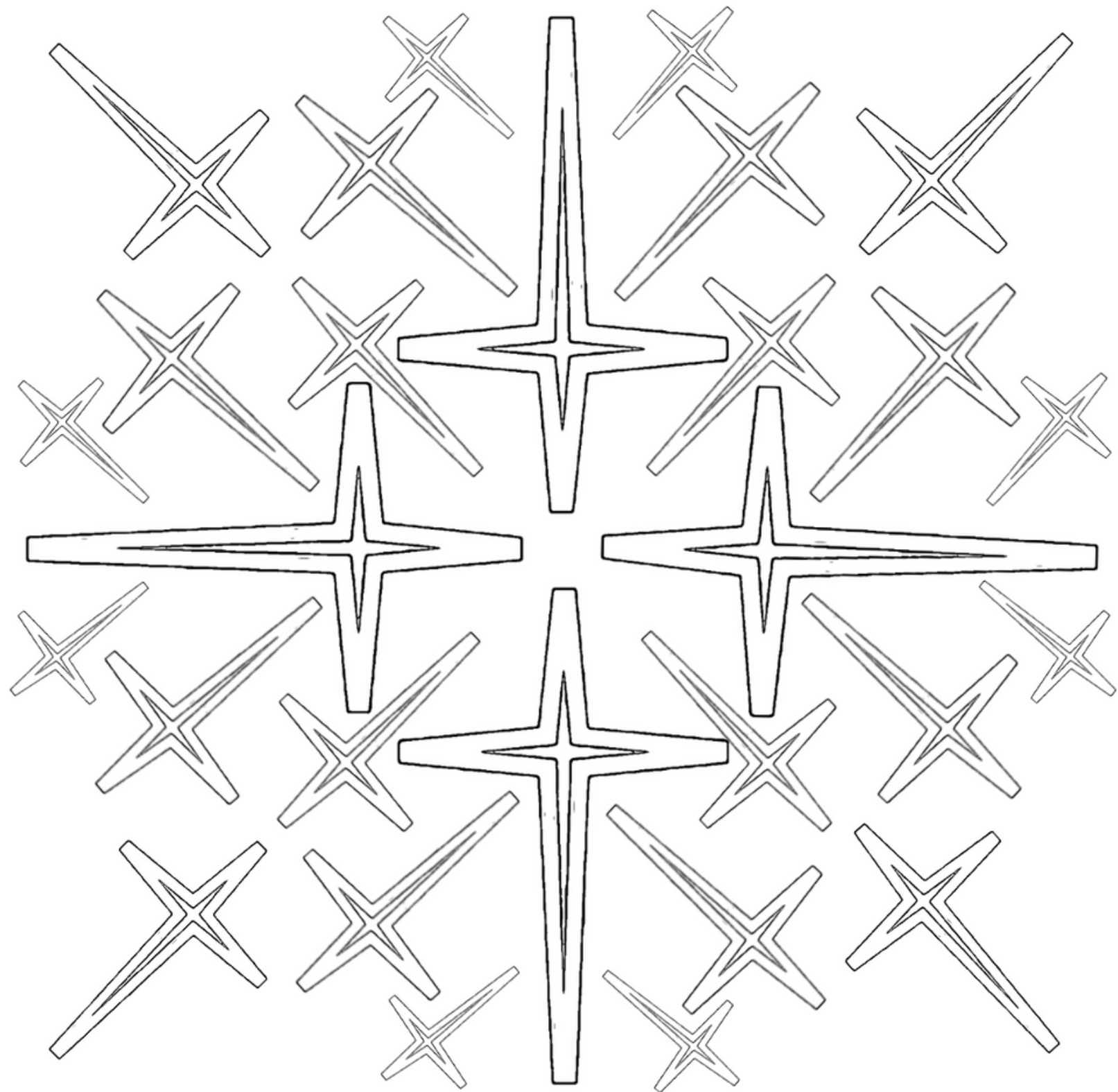
